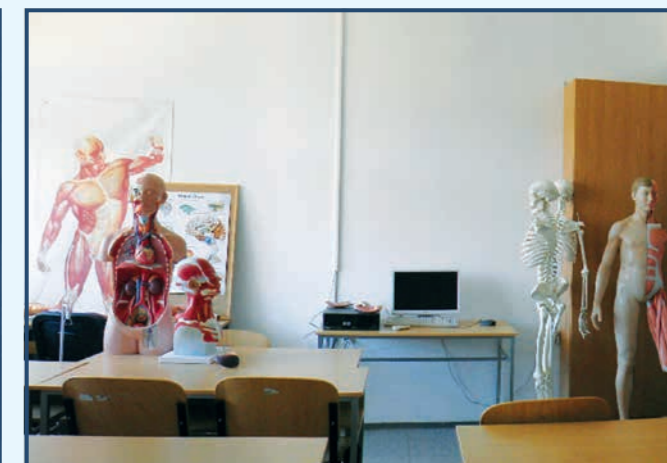

Prof. Dr. Rubin Gulaboski

Prof. Dr. Rubin Gulaboski is a Doctor of Natural Sciences. He graduated and completed master's degree in Skopje, at the Faculty of Natural Sciences and Mathematics, and he earned a doctorate degree in Greifswald, Germany. He was the first winner of a DAAD scholarship for doctoral studies from Macedonia. From 2004 until 2007 he was a postdoctoral student at the University of Porto, Portugal, and from 2008 until 2010 he was a postdoctoral student at the Saarland University in Germany, as a scholarship user of the foundation Alexander von Humboldt. He is the only scientist from Macedonia who was a scholarship user of the two most important scientific foundations in the world, DAAD and Alexander von Humboldt. He is the author of more than 100 original scientific papers, published in renowned scientific journals such as the Journal of the American Chemical Society, Nature Scientific Reports, Langmuir, Journal of Physical Chemistry, Electrochemistry Communications, and many others. He is the author of two patents published in the EU, and three monographs published by Springer. Prof. Dr. Gulaboski is one of the 10 most quoted authors from Macedonia in all fields. He is the author of approximately 30 theoretical scientific papers where he gives his contribution to clarify the mechanisms of activity of many proteins in conditions of voltammetric

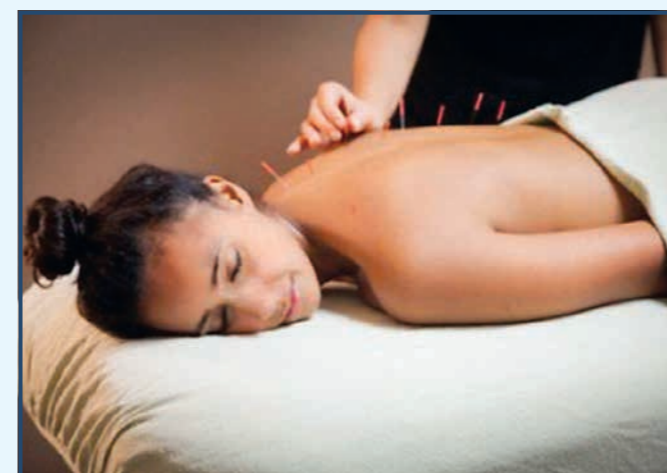
techniques. He held plenary lectures, and he stayed at more than 30 universities in the EU. He participated in the realization of more than 25 scientific-research projects in the EU and in Macedonia. He is a member of editorial boards of approximately 10 scientific journals. He is one of the leaders of the largest project in Macedonia, SOE DAAD, through which more than 300 students and employees from Macedonia and the University Goce Delcev obtained scholarships for studies or scholarships for scientific research.



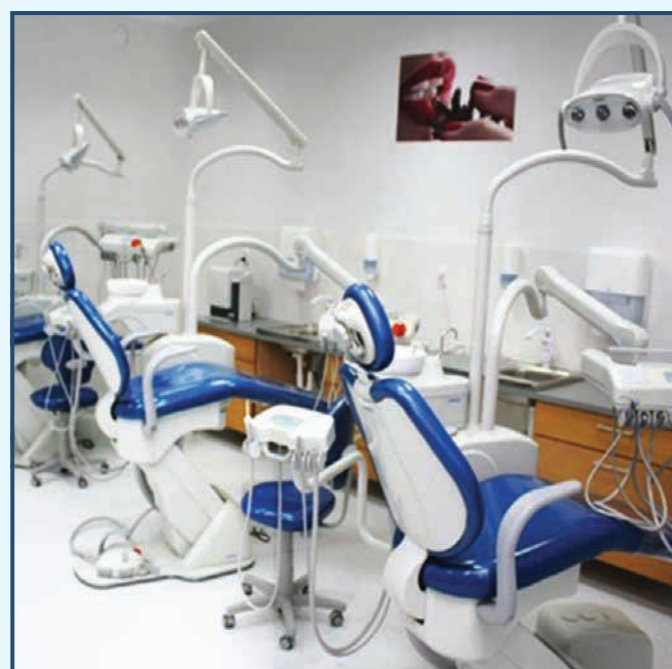
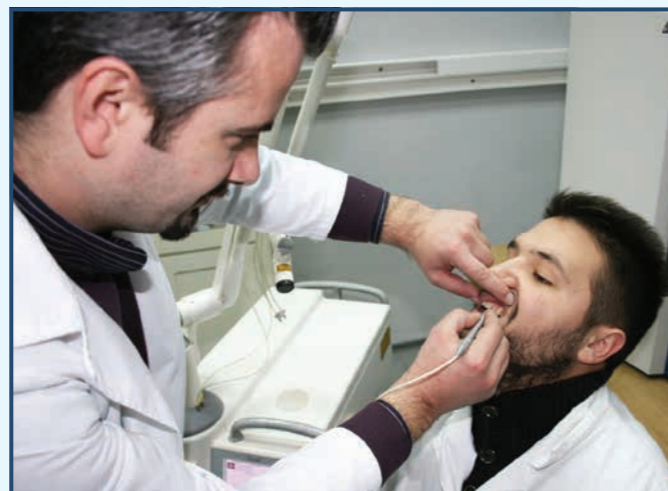
The Faculty of Medical Sciences is the largest faculty within the University Goce Delcev – Stip, and with more than 3.200 students in its composition, it is currently the second largest faculty in Macedonia. It was established in 2007 as a Higher Health School, and in 2008 it was transformed into Faculty of Medical Sciences. In 2009 at the Faculty of Medical Sciences there were already three accredited academic study programs (General Medicine, Dental Medicine, and Pharmacy) and 6 study programs for vocational studies (Obstetricians, Nurses, Physical Therapists, Optometrists, Dental Technicians, and Medical Laboratory Technicians). In addition to the study programs for second cycle studies (in total 12 specialist accredited programs), at the Faculty of Medical Sciences there is also an accredited study program – master studies in Radiopharmacy, which is performed in English language. Furthermore, since 2014 at the faculty there are accredited study programs for doctoral studies in biomedicine, neurosciences, dental medicine, general medicine, and pharmacy. Since 2014 at the Faculty of Medical Sciences specializations are realized for graduates in Dental Medicine, Pharmacy, and Medical Sciences.



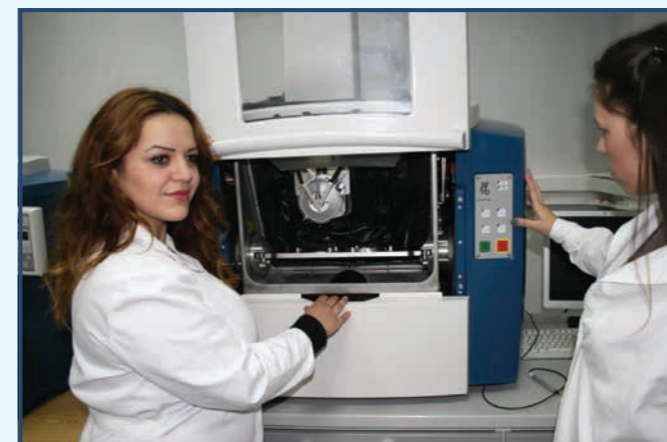
Being one of the largest faculties in Macedonia, the main focus of all employees at the faculty is the provision of quality education and transfer of knowledge and experiences from the teachers to the students. For this purpose, at the Faculty of Medical Sciences there was a period of intensive investments, whereby the most modern equipment was used in order to fully equip the laboratories for Dental Medicine, Pharmacy, Dental Technicians, Physical Therapy, and Optometry. In addition, at the Faculty there are also functional laboratories for molecular biology, bioelectrochemistry and physiology, and the faculty also disposes of its own simulation center for the students of General Medicine. University Stomatology Clinic exists at the faculty, and it is one of the most modern in the Balkan. For the purpose of realization of clinical teaching, the faculty has concluded cooperation agreements with the Special Hospitals Filip Vtori, Remedika, Tokuda, and with the Clinical Hospital in Stip, where the students perform practical clinical exercises. The Center for Traditional Chinese Medicine also functions within the Faculty of Medical Sciences.



The students are in the center of attention of all employees at the Faculty of Medical Sciences. Through its partner institutions in Germany, USA, China, Italy, Switzerland, Croatia, Russia, Portugal, Bulgaria, Romania, Turkey, Poland, France, Ireland, and Sweden, many students have the opportunity to realize study stays and practical training in world-renowned institutions. In addition, through the bodies of the University Goce Delcev and through the projects of the employees, scholarships are provided for a large part of the students, wherewith their costs for study and training are covered. The students also have the opportunity to be directly involved in the scientific-research work as early as in the initial years of their studies. Through projects funded by the University Goce Delcev Stip and from foreign foundations, the students have the opportunity to be financially supported for their scientific-research work. After graduation, some of the graduates leave in order to work as doctors or healthcare workers in the United States or in some of states the European Union. Thereby, the nostrifications of the diplomas of the graduates at the Faculty of Medical Sciences within the University Goce Delcev are smoothly performed in countries such as the United States, Germany, Sweden, Italy, and Turkey. The employees of the Faculty of Medical Sciences within the University Goce Delcev Stip are top experts in the fields of gynecology, surgery, emergency medicine, infectious diseases, microbiology, pharmacy, oral surgery, dental medicine, prosthetics, biochemistry, molecular biology, and chemistry. Thereby, two of the ten most quoted scientists from Macedonia of all times are active professors at the Faculty of Medical Sciences within the University Goce Delcev Stip.



Taking into consideration the fact that here, but also worldwide, there are increasing discussions about the importance of promotion of health and raising the level of health culture, the University Goce Delcev opened a center for recreation, relaxation, and rehabilitation. On February 1, 2015 the Recreational Center was put into operation, covering a total area of 130 m², including the Cabinet of Physical Medicine and the Cabinet of Kinezi Therapy equipped with the most modern devices for physical and aesthetic therapy, equipment for kinezi therapy, recreational devices and props. In addition, this recreational center provides modern realization of the curriculum and the practical exercises of the students from the vocational studies for physical therapists, as well as realization of the specialist study programs of second cycle.



The students have an opportunity to realize their compulsory practice and to develop and improve their professional skills. The Department of Physical Medicine and Kinezi Therapy has internationally certified and trained professional staff for work with the equipment which is available in this recreational center. All students who complete the studies at the Faculty of Medical Sciences, acquire the necessary skills that make them competitive healthcare workers on the labor market in Macedonia, as well as beyond its borders.
