## PHI HEALTHCARE CENTER ZELEZNICAR SKOPJE

*Dr. Spec. Marijana Danic was born on 27.05.1959 in Veles, where she finished primary and secondary education. She finished higher education and graduated from the Faculty of Medicine within the University Ss. Cyril and Methodius in Skopje. Upon graduation, she started her work experience in the PHI Healthcare Center Zeleznicar in 1988, as a doctor of general medicine. She worked at this position until 2000, when she successfully completed her specialization in ophthalmology and continued to work in the PHI Healthcare Center Zeleznicar as a specialist ophthalmologist. In the period from 2003 until 2006 she was working as a Director of the PHI Healthcare Center Zeleznicar, a period when this institution changed its location and started to operate as a modern institution in a new and more modern facility, in the city center. She mastered her work with active participation in numerous symposia and seminars in the Republic of Macedonia and abroad, and for many years she has been a member of the Association of Ophthalmologists of Macedonia, and its vice president in two terms.*

According to certain indicators, the Healthcare Center Zeleznicar started to operate back in 1923, in a building in the vicinity of what was once cinema Karposh in the settlement Debar Maalo in Skopje. During the first years since the establishment there were in total seven employees in the Healthcare Center.

With a decision of the Government of the Republic of Macedonia no.19-378/1 from 07.02.2005, the Healthcare Center Zeleznicar ceased to operate within Macedonian Railways, and became a part of the public healthcare institutions under the competence of the Ministry of Health as an independent institution named *Public Healthcare Institution Healthcare Center Zeleznicar Skopje*. Today in the PHI Healthcare Center Zeleznicar Skopje there are 46 employees in total, of which there are 10 doctors specialists, 12 nurses, 11 employees from other healthcare staff, and 13 administrative and auxiliary technical employees. They all provide healthcare and health services to patients from the region of Skopje and the surrounding, but also many services for patients from the entire territory of the Republic of Macedonia. The work is organized in accordance with "My Term" and patients are being taken care of every day in two shifts.

In accordance with its organizational structure, the PHI Healthcare Center Zeleznicar provides healthcare services within the following activities: *Service for preventive healthcare of children up to 6 years of age, Service for occupational medicine, Service for Biochemical Laboratory, Service for specialist-consultative healthcare,*



*Dermatology, Psychiatrics, Neurology, ORL (Otorhinolaryngology), Ophthalmology, Internal Medicine, Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Radiology and Insulin Pharmacy with a depot of medicines. The PHI Healthcare Center Zeleznicar Skopje also provides services on the basis of various authorizations issued by appropriate institutions: previous, regular (systematic and periodic) and extraordinary health examinations of workers, workplace risk assessment, training for first aid in the workplace, training for first aid for candidates for drivers and vessels, examinations for issuance of all types of medical certificates and determination of blood type.*



The administrative officers and the auxiliary technical staff are organized in three services: *Service for normative legal and professional affairs, Service for financial-accounting affairs and Service for auxiliary-technical works*, which together with the healthcare workers, participate in the realization of the healthcare activity. There are also concessionaires in the premises of the PHI Healthcare Center Zeleznicar Skopje, as follows: *eight general practitioners, one general pediatrician, five general stomatologists, one oral surgeon, three prosthetics specialists, one gynecologist and two dental technicians.*
