Master of Medical Science – cardiologist**

Sci. Dr. Sretko Jovanov, Master of Medical Science – cardiologist, was born on 13.01.1958 in Negorci. He finished primary education in his birthplace, and he finished secondary education in Skopje, in the secondary medical school “Dr. Panche Karagjovov”. In 1982 he graduated at the Medical Faculty within the University “Ss. Cyril and Methodius” – Skopje. In 1983 he was employed in the Medical Center Gevgelija, in the general outpatient clinic and ambulance with home visits. In 1992 he was appointed secondary care doctor at the Department of Internal Medicine, and he started his specialization in internal medicine in the Clinical Center in Skopje. He specialized in 1996. During the specialization he acquired education on independent work in the field of 2D echocardiography and coronary stress test. In 1995 he started postgraduate studies in cardiology, and in 1999 he defended his master's thesis titled “Left Ventricular Function In Acute Anteroseptal Myocardial Infarction – Aspects Of Conservative And Interventional Treatment”, and acquired the right to professional title: Master of Medical Science – cardiologist. Since 1996 he has been working as a specialist internist – cardiologist at the Department of Internal Medicine and the Cabinet for 2D and 4D Echocardiography in the General Hospital Gevgelija, where he is a Head of the Internal Medicine Service. In 2007, after he finished professional training in the field of health care management, he obtained a Certificate from the Medical Faculty, University “Ss. Cyril and Methodius” – Skopje. This same year the Ministry of Health issued him a Certificate on Passed Exam for Director of a Public Health Care Institution. In 2013 he successfully passed the exam in the field of public procurement, organized by the Bureau for Public Procurement. In the period from May until June 2013 he mastered his knowledge in the field of echo color Doppler of the extracranial blood vessels in Group Florence Nightingale – Istanbul, Turkey. Since 2006 to date he performs the duty Director of the PHI General Hospital Gevgelija.



The beginnings of organized health care of the PHI General Hospital – Gevgelija date back to the early 50^s of the past century, through a health care station that operated on this territory, and later on it grew into a Health Care Center, while in 1971 it became a Medical Center. It operates as an independent health care institution since 01.01.2005, with a Decision of the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Macedonia, when the existing Medical Center transformed into three new health care institutions, General Hospital, Health Care Center, and Psychiatric Hospital. The PHI General Hospital – Gevgelija is a

public health care institution for provision of health care services within the following fields: hospital health care and treatment; specialist-consultative activity; physical therapy; and medical rehabilitation.



The basic goals of the hospital include: provision of health care; education of the population for prevention of diseases; application of modern methods of treatment; education of the existing staff and new staff; improvement and modernization of the equipment for treatment, and improvement of the hospital conditions for treatment of patients. The seat of the PHI General Hospital is in Gevgelija, and it provides health care on the territories of the municipalities of Gevgelija, Bogdanci, Dojran and Valandovo. The position in the south of the Republic of Macedonia, in the vicinity of the most frequently crossed border crossing with the Republic of Greece, as well as the fact that the international highway also passes on this territory, also implies direct connection with the European Union.

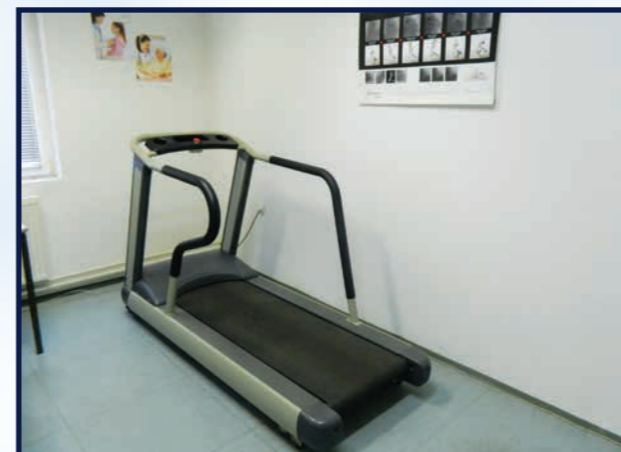
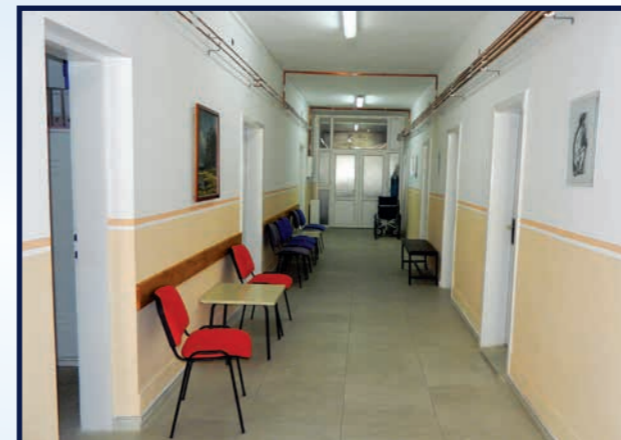


In accordance with the registration, the subject of activity of the Hospital includes:

The PHI General Hospital – Gevgelija performs its activities through the following organizational units: Internal Service; Service for Childhood Diseases; Surgical Service; Service for Protection of Women and Mothers; Department for Anesthesia, Resuscitation and Intensive Care; Laboratory Activity with Biochemical Laboratory; Pathohistological Diagnostics; Service for Provision of Medications and Sanitation Materials; Autopsy and Biopsy Room; Neuropsychiatric Activity; Service for Eye Diseases; Service for Diseases of the Ears, Nose and Throat; Orthopedic Activity; Activity for Dermatological and Venereal Diseases; Activity for Infectious Diseases with Isolation; Service for Physical Medicine and Medical Rehabilitation; General Legal and Economic Service; Technical Service; Service for Transport of Patients with an ambulance to other institutions and health care institutions of tertiary level. In order to successfully perform the obligations to its patients, the PHI General Hospital- Gevgelija has good staffing, with 162 full time employees and 10 volunteers with the following structure: 22 doctors specialists; 15 doctors of medicine on specialization; 1 psychologist; 1 pharmacist; 1 social worker; 1 graduate economist; 1 law graduate; 1 graduate professor of popular defense; 1 graduate physical therapist; 3 senior x-ray technicians; 1 senior nurse; 1 senior physical therapist; 47 nurses and technicians; 7 obstetricians; 7 laboratory technicians; 2 anaesthetists; 1 pharmaceutical technician; 6 physical therapists; 16 paramedics; 1 photo laboratory technician; 2 nurses; 3 drivers; 10 administrative workers; 10 hygienists and 9 persons of non-medical staff. The following specialists perform their activity in the PHI General Hospital Gevgelija: 6 internists; 4 surgeons, 2 otorhinolaryngologists; 2 ophthalmologists; 1 orthopedist, 1 urologist, 1 infectologist, 1 dermatovenerologist, 1 physiatrist; 2 neurologists; 1 psychiatrist, 1 pathologist, 1 radiologist and 15 doctors on specialization.
